

Dear Valued Customer:

Silicon Graphics is pleased to present the new IRIX 6.5.2 maintenance and feature release. Starting with IRIX 6.5, Silicon Graphics created a new software upgrade release strategy to deliver both the maintenance (6.5.2m) and feature (6.5.2f) streams. This upgrade is part of a family of releases that enhances IRIX 6.5.

There are several benefits to this strategy: it provides periodic fixes to IRIX, it assists in managing upgrades, and it supports all platforms. Most importantly, system administrators can maintain just one network distribution or set of CDs to support all Silicon Graphics systems and peripherals at their site.

Additional information on this strategy and how it affects you is included in the **updated** *IRIX Installation Instructions* manual contained in this package. With this letter, you have received either the IRIX 6.5.2 Workstation Update or the IRIX 6.5.2 Server/Workstation Update. These updates differ only in accessory software. What you receive is dependent upon your system type.

DCE

The DCE/DFS 1.2.2 client is available for IRIX 6.5.2. The client includes support for threads (running on POSIX threads), rpc, time, security, CDS, and DFS. The security component is based on Kerberos V and will interoperate with Kerberos V servers. The DFS client provides fast cache-based access to remote data. The DCE/DFS client for IRIX 6.5.2 has been tested using servers from IBM, Hewlett Packard, Transarc, and others.

The MIPSpro 7.2.1.2m maintenance release is the second update release containing bug fixes for the MIPSpro 7.2.1 Compilers development and front-end products. Overlay images for Compiler Runtime Library fixes such as ftn_eoe and compiler_eoe are shipped separately with the IRIX 6.5.2m/f maintenance and feature releases.

Robolnst

Your IRIX 6.5.2 Installation Tools CD includes the RoboInst software. RoboInst is a software tool to automate software installation on networked computer systems. Refer to the *IRIX Installation and Licensing* book and the RoboInst release notes.

Teleffect

Teleffect is a program that allows you to control a group of networked computers using the keyboard and mouse attached to one of the computers. This creates the effect of having one giant desktop that spans multiple monitors. When the mouse moves off the right-hand edge of one connected screen it appears on the left-hand edge of the next connected screen. Text that has been cut on one system may be pasted on any connected system. Teleffect 1.0 supports Microsoft Windows NT 4.0 Service Pack 3 and Silicon Graphics IRIX versions 6.2, 6.3, 6.4, and 6.5.
